Since the last edition of Safety Soapbox there have been 65 incidents, serious enough to be reported to WorkSafe Victoria from the construction, utility, quarrying and mining industries.

Below is a summary of these incidents.

| Date | Location | Injury | Incident summary |
|--------|-----------------|----------------|--|
| 45 No. | Disables | description | A service and a service to find a service service |
| 15 Nov | Blackburn | Near miss | A crew was one metre deep trying to find a gas service to bore past it. The service was damaged with a bucket trying to clear the hole out. |
| 15 Nov | Toorak | Fracture | Employee crushed his middle finger between a concrete slave and steel beam while he was maneuvering a steel beam. |
| 15 Nov | Ringwood | Puncture | Employee was installing timber frames with a nail gun when a nail skewed out of the timber into his left hand. |
| 15 Nov | Carlton | Electric shock | Two employees suffered electric shocks/burns when the boom they were using to install a sign on a building struck power lines with a metal track. |
| 15 Nov | Surf Coast | Crush | Employee crushed his finger between two rocks he was moving. |
| 18 Nov | Gippsland | Crush | Employee slipped and fell from a cranes step, when the crane started and began to move forward. |
| 18 Nov | Lilydale | Crush | Employee squashed his finger between a loader bucker and rail plate while unloading plates into the bucket. |
| 18 Nov | North Melbourne | Bruising | During stripping of formwork, an employee was struck on the shoulder by a piece of ply (300mm x 1200mm) falling three levels down. |
| 18 Nov | South Melbourne | Eye injury | Employee was grinding wearing goggles, goggles steamed up; he removed them to wipe them clean and got a foreign body stuck in his eye. |
| 18 Nov | Melbourne | Near miss | During a concrete pour on level 40 the pump operator noticed a drop in pressure and found the line had blown on level two. |
| 19 Nov | South Yarra | Near miss | Employee was leaning over a hand rail on the roof of a building when it came loose and fell approximately 50 metres into a loading zone on the ground floor. |
| 19 Nov | Port Melbourne | Near miss | A 100 tonne crane was transferring a scissor lift out of a stair well when the lift detached from the crane and fell a few meters to the ground. |

| 19 Nov | Footscray | Laceration | Employee was cutting metal with a grinder when it kicked back into his lower leg. |
| 19 Nov | Bendigo | Near miss | A crane was lifting a large piece of double-glazed glass that broke and dropped shards to the ground four metres below. |
| 19 Nov | Geelong | Leg injury | Employee was struck in the leg by an excavator. |
| 20 Nov | Belgrave | Puncture | Employee entered a one metre deep excavation when he landed on a rio bar and punctured his foot. |
| 20 Nov | Langwarrin | Puncture | Employee shot himself through the hand with a nail gun while he was framing. |
| 20 Nov | Melbourne | Concussion | Inspector bumped his head on a boom lift during a site inspection. |
| 20 Nov | Port Melbourne | Laceration | A door being transported to a loading bay slipped and fell off a scissor lift, lacerating an employee's leg. |
| 20 Nov | Reservoir | Near miss | A crane was being raised with a load but failed to stop when it reached full height, causing a side plate lifting hook (weighing about 10kg) to fall to the ground. |
| 20 Nov | Sunbury | Laceration | Employee standing on a ladder dropped a chisel onto a colleague who was holding the ladder in place. |
| 20 Nov | Melbourne | Near miss | Concrete dropped five metres to the ground after a pump blew. |
| 20 Nov | Ocean Grove | Near miss | A gas line was hit by a bobcat and began to leak. |
| 20 Nov | Ballarat | Laceration | Employee cut his leg with a circular saw. |
| 21 Nov | Wantirna | Electric shock | Employee received electric shock while modifying a main switch extension. |
| 21 Nov | Wodonga | Fracture | Employee fractured his foot when he was struck by an excavator. |
| 22 Nov | Carrum | Fracture | Contractor fell off a ladder and broke his wrist. |
| 22 Nov | Footscray | Near miss | Mini excavator tipped over and off a truck with the operator inside while picking up buckets and other attachments. |
| 22 Nov | Wodonga | Laceration | Employee was cutting chimney flashing when he cut his finger on an edge. |
| 22 Nov | Richmond | Fracture | Employee fell over when his hand became stuck in a wheelie bin handle, fracturing his finger and knocking his head. |



| 22 Nov | Cape Otway | Laceration | Contractor standing between two parked trucks when one drove away hitting and dragging him, lacerating his leg. |

| 25 Nov | Tullamarine | Near miss | During demolition works a copper pipe fell from level two approximately nine metres to level one, landing on a restaurant floor. |
| 25 Nov | Melbourne | Fracture | Employee was pulling a table when he tripped over and fell backwards, fracturing two ribs. |
| 25 Nov | Carlton | Fracture and laceration | Contractor was placing a heavy grate down when it slipped and fell on his finger. |
| 26 Nov | Mitcham | Laceration | Employee was installing metal batons on a roof when his drill slipped and shot past a baton's raw edge, lacerating his finger. |
| 26 Nov | Morwell | Near miss | A gantry crane sling hook failed when a box was lifted. |
| 26 Nov | Springvale | Near miss | A six foot long steel z-bar reo fell approximately three metres from a bridge above, landing on mud below. |
| 26 Nov | Whittlesea | Fracture | Employee stepped out of his truck, missed the handle, fell to the ground and landed on his elbow. |
| 26 Nov | Moonee Ponds | Electric shock | Apprentice received an electric shock while putting up cold water main runs. |
| 26 Nov | Lara | Near miss | Gas lines running through a property were hit while concrete slab peer holes were being drilled. |
| 26 Nov | Ballarat | Electric shock | Employee received an electric shock while doing electrical work on an overhead power line from an EWP. |
| 27 Nov | Wodonga | Laceration | Employee was struck in the face by a blade of an angle grinder. |
| 27 Nov | Dandenong | Fractures | Employee was on a ladder when he lost balance and fell on his wrist and shoulder. |
| 27 Nov | Brighton | Laceration | Employee lacerated his thumb while using a box cutter. |
| 27 Nov | Cranbourne | Near miss | A bore hole digger ruptured a running gas line. |
| 27 Nov | Thomastown | Near miss | A gas service was broken while a new water main trench was being dug. |
| 27 Nov | Melbourne | Near miss | A piece of pre-cast panel chipped off during installation, hitting a gantry then dropping from height. |
| 27 Nov | Melbourne | Near miss | Concrete slurry fell from height landing near and on employees. |



| ^S 27 Nov | Northcote | Laceration | Apprentice lacerated finger between two pieces of flashing while he was cladding a wall. |

| 27 Nov | Kilmore | Fracture | Employee broke his wrist when the magnetic drill he was using became locked and spun because the drill bit had become jammed. |
| 27 Nov | Moonee Ponds | Electric shock | Apprentice received an electric shock when he brushed past some live wires. |
| 28 Nov | Mentone | Laceration | Employee was pulling off metal strapping with a hammer when the strapping snapped and sliced his wrist. |
| 28 Nov | Dandenong | Laceration | Employee amputated his finger and damaged thumb ligaments when he made contact with a radial arm saw blade that had kept running after being switched off. |
| 28 Nov | Blackburn | Laceration | Contractor slipped on some timber and grabbed a timber frame for support when his arm slipped, catching on a speed brace. |
| 28 Nov | Hawthorn | Laceration | Employee lacerated his wrist while using a grinder. |
| 28 Nov | Carlton | Near miss | A reinforced steel bar fell from the shoulders of an employee, dropping from level six to four. |
| 28 Nov | Ascot Vale | Laceration | Employee lacerated his hand while using an electric saw. |
| 28 Nov | Williamstown | Electric shock | Employee received an electric shock from a live cable while removing pieces of ceiling by hand during demolition. |
| 28 Nov | Werribee | Near miss | Employee was accessing a ceiling to run a cable when he noticed a spark on the ceiling and found a live electrical cable touching some mesh reinforcement. |
| 28 Nov | Northcote | Laceration | Employee was laying tarp on a metal corrugated roof when he lost footing and fell, lacerating his arm. |
| 28 Nov | Melbourne | Bruising | A concrete boom pump's heavy steel ladder dislodged and fell from height, striking an employee's neck and forearm. |

| 15 Nov | Mine | Electric shock | Employee received an electric shock while hosing down process plant. |
| 17 Nov | Mine | Near miss | Over burden dump area - batter collapsed and partially covered one side of a dozer operating at the toe of the |

| 16 Nov | Mine | Bruising | Employee was struck on the back of the neck when erecting a power pole. |
| 22 Nov | Mine | Laceration | Employee was attempting to undo a pump valve which released and hand impacted a sign resulting in finger laceration. |
