## 25 September 2012

Since the last edition of Safety Soapbox, there have been 66 incidents, serious enough to be reported to WorkSafe Victoria, from the construction, utility, quarrying and mining industries. Below is a summary of these incidents.

| Date | Location | Injury | Incident description |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| 7September | BUNDOORA | Near miss | 4.5 metre roof flashing that was being lifted by a mobile crane. It fell off and landed to the ground. Fall height approx 4 metres. |
|  | TULLAMARINE | Laceration to left thumb | Carpenter was sharpening his chisel, as he went to put it back into his pouch, he slipped and it caused a laceration to his hand (left). He was taken to the medical centre for surgery. |
|  | WAURN PONDS (QUARRY) | Injuries unknown | Excavator driver was moving rock from a rock blast (on a base of rock), using a 5 T rock hammer but overnight the ground became soft due to rain, and the excavator sank and has tipped over onto its side. Driver was sent to the doctors to be checked out. |
|  | WODONGA | Deep laceration to left knee | Male using 9 inch angle grinder that cut back on him into his left knee causing a deep laceration. Approximately 50 stitches required. |
|  | HAZELWOOD | Near miss | Short section of scaffold tube has fallen from one level to the next, approx 1.8 m . It landed beside a worker. |
|  | EPPING | Four broken vertebrae and laceration to elbow | Air conditioning installer was on a ladder fitting off the heating. He fell from about 1.5 m |
| 10September | BELMONT | Severe laceration and tendon and nerve damage. | Work experience student, 16, under supervision of a 4th year apprentice, ran a saw into his left arm causing requiring surgery |
|  | COSTERFIELD (MINE) | Near miss | Miner was boring the rock face when a large slab of rock fell from the face and landed on the drill steel that he was using, he was forced to move out the way of the falling rock avoiding injury. |
|  | NORTHCOTE | Suspected fractured ankle | Dogger was on 3rd floor and stood outside on piece of timber with no handrail and flooring collapsed. Worker fell from height of 3 metres. |
|  | COLAC | Near miss | Contractor crashed the forklift into a parked trailer. Extensive damage to the forklift. |
|  | KANGAROO FLAT | Near miss | Connecting a 20 mm gas service to a house the gas line has caught fire presumably from the rotary hoe sparks. Road Closed. Police and CFA are in attendance. Gas being burnt off until gas mains can be turned off. |
|  | SOUTH YARRA | Severed tip of little finger | Carpenter was working at the site relocating a staircase with another worker when the staircase slipped crushing/trapping his left hand little finger. |
|  | MELBOURNE | Laceration to finger | Worker was cutting furring channel using a drop saw. The cut end fell off the end of the rollers and as it kicked up, the operator's hand contact the running down saw blade resulting in a laceration to the right index finger. |
|  | BELLFIELD | Fracture to arm | A vehicle was travelling in the worksite, the driver lost control of the vehicle and it struck a roadside tree at low speed. A passenger in the rear was injured. |
| $\begin{array}{r} 11 \\ \text { September } \end{array}$ | COSTERFIELD (MINE) | Laceration to face | Employee was installing a resin bolt ground support. He was holding the bolt with his right hand and he lent out to grab the drill and the bolt and plate fell off and struck him on the chin. Stitches required. |
|  | MENTONE | Near miss | Worker was in process of clearing away dirt and lifted arm of boom, swinging it wrong way and smashed LHS cabin of excavator. Broken glass and dint to top of cabin. No injuries. |
|  | FRESHWATER CREEK | Injuries unknown | Cement truck rolled over the driver. Taken to hospital with minor injuries. |

|  | PORT FAIRY | Laceration to right thumb and hand | Apprentice plumber was cutting a sheet of iron (10m long) at the back of a house. It slipped and fell on the back of his hand. Stitches required. |

| 12September | SOUTHBANK | Near miss | Gust of wind picked up two pieces of corrugated iron (approx 1.5 metres $\times 900 \mathrm{ml}$ ) from level 22 and blew it into an adjoining property (approx 50 metres away). No injuries, no damage. |
|  | RINGWOOD | Near miss | Excavator hit 22kva overhead powerlines. The lines have fallen and electricity company is on site making repairs. |
|  | WILLIAMSTOWN | Laceration through bone on left thumb and hand | Employee was cutting bearer with an electric saw. The saw kicked back and cut into hand. Surgery required. |
| 13September | WANTIRNA | Puncture wound. Full injuries unknown | Worker was assisting in assembling an air conditioner grill received a puncture wound to his index finger. While it was being drilled the screw went through grill and into his finger. He later went to hospital and was kept in overnight to determine if there was any tendon/nerve damage. |
|  | SPRINGVALE | Laceration to the forehead and under the left eye | Worker fell off the ladder hitting his head on the tile cutter. |
|  | FLEMINGTON | Crushed right middle finger | Employee was uncoupling a trailer when the trailer coupling crushed his finger between the coupling and the ground. |
|  | MELBOURNE | Electric shock | Employee was mixing water and concrete with a mixer. Someone accidentally kicked the bucket over with the mixer still working and the employee received electric shock when the mixer was picked up out of the water. |
|  | SUMMERLANDS | Suspected slipped disc | Employee moving concrete blocks (30-40kgs each). He tried to lift one onto his shoulder to carry it resulting in lower back pain taken to hospital by ambulance. |
|  | TEMPLESTOWE | Suspected broken thumb | Employee fell from a first story building site while building the guard railing. He fell 2.4 metres and was taken to hospital by work colleague. |
| 14September | HALLAM | Laceration and degloving of skin on left hand index finger | Employee was using a pedestal drill at the host employers workplace. The glove that he was wearing got caught in the drill piece. |
|  | TORQUAY | Injuries unknown | Employee has turned on a hydrant for the underground irrigation. When he did this the hydrant came off the ground and hit the employee in the knee and in the head. Unable to move leg. Currently waiting for ambulance. |
|  | RICHMOND | Near miss | Concrete pouring of a deck taking place. The void in the area of the slab partially collapsed. |
|  | BAYSWATER | Laceration to left arm | Contractor stepped down from a ladder and caught his left arm (just above the elbow) on a sharp piece of metal on a portable building. Taken to hospital by ambulance, and requires surgery. |
|  | MELBOURNE | Near miss | Internal demolition was being conducted to pull down the ceiling when a piece of masonite $300 \mathrm{~mm} \times 300 \mathrm{~mm}$ fell through a boarded first floor window onto the pavement below. |
|  | CAMPBELL FIELD | Crush injury right forearm and hand | Electrician was using a travel tower ( 23 metre) to do some electrical work on the advertisement sign on the side of a building. He was in the bucket with his arm resting on the side when the tower spontaneously moved causing the arm to be crushed up underneath of the sign. |
|  | MELBOURNE | Near miss | Falling object: a $100 \mathrm{~mm} \times 30 \mathrm{~mm}$ aluminium packer sheet fell from the 10th floor onto the outside of the no go zone on Flinders Lane after it slipped out of an employees hands. |


|  | ABOTTSFORD | Near miss | Worker drilling into a concrete slab for precast panel props and struck a live electrical cable in the cement. |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
|  | BROOKLYN | Multiple cracked ribs, punctured lung | Labourer had finished his shift for the day and was having a shower on site. Reported that he fell in the shower. Apparently when he got home he became unwell and went to hospital for surgery. |
| $\begin{array}{r} 17 \\ \text { September } \end{array}$ | DOCKLANDS | Crush injury to right thumb | Employee was laying formwork when the formwork jack dropped out and crushed the tip of his right thumb. Surgery required. |
|  | PAKENHAM | Laceration to legs | Worker was cutting the metal strapping off a pack of glass that had been delivered and was sitting on an "A" frame when the glass sheets sprang out after one of the metal bands had been cut and pinned the worker by his legs. |
|  | TRARALGON SOUTH | Near miss | Power station outage, internal boiler (level 3 inside the boiler) was grinding a steel plate approx $1000 \mathrm{~mm} \times 200 \mathrm{~mm} \times 5 \mathrm{~mm}$ approx $8-12 \mathrm{~kg}$ and it has over balanced and fallen through two scaffold planks and hit level two, and dislodged another plank and has fallen to level one, and dislodged a further two scaffold planks and has come to rest approx 1500mm below that. There were two employees approx 4 metres from the fallen plate on the first level. |
|  | ST KILDA | Broken leg | Contractor was operating a concrete road-saw when it tipped over onto his leg. |
|  | DANDENONG SOUTH | Laceration to finger | Employee was using a Mag drill, and had it on the floor, changing the drill bit, and has leaned on the trigger, and the drill has started, resulting in a laceration to his finger. Stitches required. |
|  | BRUNSWICK | Near miss | Work was taking place using a tower crane on Friday. The hook and chains ran over by 10 meters and fell to the ground level approx 1.5 meters from where the dogman was standing. The tower is being serviced. |
|  | SOUTHBANK | Lacerated head | Worker was near a tower crane that was being dismantled when a spanner type of tool (podgy) fell down to the loading bay and fell onto worker's hard hat causing a laceration to his head. |
|  | BORONIA | Near miss | 20 metre high trees being cut down by excavator in darkness near homes. |
|  | HEIDELBERG | Sliced top off index finger left hand | Contractor was repairing vinyl when he cut index finger on left hand with knife. |
|  | SPOTSWOOD |  | An electrician was undertaking some maintenance work prior to the centre opening. Contractor was driving an EWP through the exhibition space when he hit an exhibit. The EWP nudged a column, slightly damaging it. |
| $\begin{array}{r} 18 \\ \text { September } \end{array}$ | CANTERBURY | Hand and head injury | Employee fell from a ladder on a domestic construction site while completing some painting. Employee was admitted to hospital overnight. |
|  | YARRAWONGA | Degloved and part amputated finger | Truck driver was on the ladder of the back of the truck when he has slipped on the ladder and caught his wedding ring (left ring finger) on the corner of the ladder. He fell approx 1metre but the ring was caught. |
|  | ALTONA | Near miss | Contractor was working on site unloading scaffold components. It's possible he drove into a crane prop and didn't report this before leaving the site. This has led to the crane being unestablished The crane has been immobilised and can't be used and crane company is coming out to look at it now. Risk is that the crane may topple over. |
|  | MELBOURNE | Right knee cap injured | Employer injured his right knee cap while installing a steel door. His knee knocked into the door while installing it. |
|  | WODONGA | Fractured left arm | Male was walking backwards using a sucker hose and lost his balance and his left leg went into open pit. Put arm out to brace fall and landed |

|  | DERRIMUT | Serious laceration to the right side of his neck | Welder was using an angle grinder on the roof, cutting some steel, when the angle grinder bit and jumped, cutting his neck. Stitches required. |
|  | ST HELENA | Left shoulder dislocated | Subcontractor tripped over an edge of concrete on the footpath and popped his left shoulder. He was taken to hospital and the shoulder was put back into place. |
|  | CARAPOOK | Complaining of sore back, legs and fingers | 32 year old male employee was in a raised boom lift at a height of approx 4 metres. Heard a crack and the whole thing went sideways. Full extent of injuries unknown. |
|  | KEW | Suspected heart attack | Male, age unknown Setting up profiles for bricks, became clammy and sweaty, called the '1300 nurse number' and was advised to contact get to hospital. An ambulance was called. |
|  | WARRANDYTE | Unknown | Unsafe asbestos removal during house renovation. |
|  | DANDENONG SOUTH | Squashed ring finger right hand | Worker caught his ring finger of right hand between the protective guard and sander belt of a hand held portable electric belt sander. Finger squashed in sander unable to remove sander. Taken to hospital by ambulance where finger was removed from sander. |
|  | COLLINGWOOD | Fractured leg and lacerations to face, arms and leg | Truck driver attended a site to pick up an excavator. While standing on the tray of the truck, the driver was moving the chains from the back of the truck so that the excavator could be driven onto the tray, when he fell off the truck, landing on his face. |
|  | DEER PARK | Lacerated neck | Worker was using a 9 inch angle grinder to cut a steel beam, when the wheel grabbed and kicked backed and hit him in the neck. |
| 19 September | MOUNT MARTHA | Crush injury to right little finger | Labourer was unloading an empty water barrier from back of a ute when the barrier slipped and crushed his right hand little finger between barrier and end of ute. He was wearing gloves. Stitches required. |
|  | SPOTSWOOD | Laceration to shin | Bricklayer tripped while working on scaffold. Lacerated his shin, surgery required. |
|  | BALLARAT | Near miss | While using a 2.5 ton Unic UR255A with a vacuum attachment to lift glass out of a crate and place on a frame, the crane tipped and came to rest with the boom resting on adjacent brick wall. |
|  | BUNDOOORA | Near miss | Installation of new handrails was underway. Workers were hammer drilling to put chemsets into an existing staircase. As the hammer drilling was being done the workers hit something that caused a spark. Site was evacuated, pending further investigation. Electricians are investigating the unknown power source. |
|  | RICHMOND | Electric shock | Male touched the earth cable clamp of the welder while assisting the welder and sustained an electric shock. They have identified the cause: clamp was attached to a precast load in a recess that had gathered water from recent rain. |
|  | PARKVILLE | Fractured ribs | Worker was working on level 6 a scaffold. He was walking back backwards and then fell through the access ladder point. Fell approximately 1.5 meters. |
|  | MOOROOLBARK | Near miss | Contractors are undertaking water main renewals in the area. While digging a hole yesterday, an arrowhead of a pipe burster hit a gas main causing a gas escape. |
| 20 September | CASTLEMAINE | Lacerated finger | A worker was cutting product with a knife when it slipped and cut his finger. Stitches required. |
